






Sales volume in tons, million





Revenue, EUR million



Assets, EUR million




Gross profit and EBITDA, EUR million



Key financial metrics



Cost and the main expenses

The cost of goods and services increased by 21% to EUR 714 million.

Operating costs decreased by 8% to EUR 35 million.

To reduce operating costs, the Group carried out some transformations in the organizational structure: closed the dormant company in Latvia SIA Erfolg Group; merged the fertilizer warehousing company SIA Paleo to the grain elevators company SIA Linas Agro Graudu Centrs; is closing the Danish company Linas Agro A/S. The Group also implements other programs to increase efficiency of the internal processes and reduce operational costs.

Logistics expenses, accounting for 6% of the total cost, increased by 4% to EUR 42.8 million.

Financial costs went up 38% to EUR 3.7 million.

67% of revenue received from export

The main export commodity – wheat, grown in Lithuania and Latvia.

The major export destinations are:

- European countries (72%);
- Asian countries (18%);
- African countries (10%).






Achievements and changes

The sales of traditional products (wheat, rapeseed, barley) increased by 11% to 1.7 million tons.

Feedstuff sales went up 50% to 441 thousand tons.

A subsidiary company LLC LINAS AGRO UKRAINE was founded to strengthen the sourcing business in Ukraine.




Development of grain sourcing network

The own grain elevators network handled 356 thousand tons of various grains. The quantities handled in Latvia grew by 26%.




An interesting detail








Changes in trade and service network

- Dotnuva Baltic has 14 outlets in the Baltics.
- Linas Agro a network of 15 farm service centers.

The total Group's storage capacity for warehousing seeds, fertilizers and plant protection products in Lithuania and Latvia increased by 6 thousand tons to 104 thousand tons.



Achievements and changes

Seed sales have been transferred from UAB Dotnuva Baltic to AB Linas Agro, seed production run by UAB Dotnuva Baltic.

The line for mixing and packing grass seeds launched at the Dotnuva seed factory to further improve the quality of the mixtures and the packing efficiency.

The rarely used warehouse in Tukums, Latvia that have been a part of previously bought company SIA Paleo, was sold.

Construction of farmers service center in Ozolnieki, Latvia is coming to the end. It will accommodate companies SIA Linas Agro and SIA Dotnuva Baltic.

Due to poor harvest, crop production grown and sold was 24% lower than in previous year.

Achievements in milk production

Milk yields have increased: average milk yield growth was 5.6%. Significant increase in Kėdainiai District Labūnavos ŽŪB (9.6%) and Panevėžys district Žibartonių ŽŪB (12.2%).

Agricultural company Šakiai District Lukšių ŽŪB was ranked the second most effective in the category of companies in 2018 and milked at average 11,262 kg from a cow.

Sidabravo ŽŪB came in third place among the most effective milk producers, and milked 10,471 kg from a cow.



Development of milk production

A part of the cow herd was moved to a new and modern farm with milking parlor at the Šakiai District Lukšių ŽŪB agricultural company.

A new slurry storage tank was mounted at Panevėžys District Žibartonių ŽŪB agricultural company, also farms are being reconstructed.

A cattle-breeding barn was reconstructed at the agricultural company Sidabravo ŽŪB.

Achievements and changes

Exports of poultry to Sweden went up, exports of chilled chicken meat to Finland were started, expanded sales in the CIS countries. A license to export chicken products to China obtained.

The EPEF (European Poultry Efficiency Factor) of 400 achieved 54 times per year.

As much as 21 poultry houses were renovated and 6 newly built, which will allow to produce extra 1,500 tons of poultry meat per year.



AS Putnu Fabrika Kekava has received A grade BRC (British Retail Consortium) accreditation (formerly having B grade or lower rating).



An interesting detail

According to the data of the research company AC Nielsen, the chicken sausage 'Doktora' by Kekava was the most successful new product (Best New Launch) in the category of meat products in Latvia, and was ranked the third most popular food product in Latvia in 2018.
